### **Kolo Bannockburn Pinot Noir 2018**

The wonder of our single block wines is that they not only reflect the character of a tiny section of a very unique place, they are also a transparent picture of their vintage. Without the benefit of blending in wine from other parts of the region to bring in different flavour and structure, a single block wine can only show the weather and character of its exact spot. Enter the 2018 Kolo Pinot Noir – lifted, red fruited, silken and delicately spiced – a more finely boned version of previous dark and brooding vintages. Delightful.

### **Akarua Bannockburn Pinot Noir 2018**

**\$18 \$85**

Our winemaker Andrew Keenleyside is particularly enamoured with this vintage of Akarua's flagship style: "I love the transparency in this vintage of Akarua Pinot Noir. By that I mean I can really see the rugged beauty of our mountain vineyards in the wine. The wild thyme, rosehip and scrubby brambles are so present, as is a perfume of the rocks and bony soils of the mountains. Vine age is really starting to play its part, as the flavours in the fruit reflect a picture of the vineyards in a complex and intriguing way."

<b>Akarua Chardonnay 2019</b> Our lightly oaked Bannockburn Chardonnay allows the purity of the fruit to shine; lemon zest, kaffir lime leaf and clover honey. With fine linear acidity, a long mineral finish.	\$14	\$65
<b>Akarua Pinot Gris 2019</b> Pretty lifted perfume of rockmelon, Beurre Bosc pear and jasmine, with lovely texture from a small component of wild yeast barrel fermentation. Our winemaker's inspired use of French acacia barrels accentuates florals and summer fruits, a nutmeg spice note from our schist soils and a bright, fresh zesty pink grapefruit finish. <b>RUA Pinot Gris 2019</b> Mandarin flower, orange zest and jubes, ripe pears, white stonefruit - a fruit bowl of glorious fruit character from a single block in our Felton Terraces vineyard in Bannockburn, Maia. Made for the summertime, warm air on your skin and the afternoon hours stretched ahead. Just released.		\$55
<b>Akarua Sauvignon Blanc 2018</b> This wine is certified as organic from Akarua's vineyard in the Pisa sub-region. It has an abundance of peach and red apple characters on the palate. A lovely soft mouthfeel with great acidity. <i>*90 Points - Cameron Douglas MS</i>	\$14	\$60
<b>Akarua Riesling 2019</b> Boughs full of citrus blossoms here - lime, mandarin and orange; plus white stone fruit, pear and a gentle note of talc. Seriously racy with stony minerals, taut bright acidity and a fine spine of chilli and ginger spice. A single block riesling from our vineyard on Cairnmuir Road, Bannockburn.	\$13	\$55
<b>25 Steps Rosé 2019</b> Saignée style that is savoury and completely different to our beloved RUA. 100% from the jaw-droppingly beautiful terraced vineyard '25 steps' in Pisa, hand-harvested, wild fermented and aged in oak puncheons. Aching on trend with its pale antique colour, taut red fruit character of pomegranate, cherry blossom perfume and long, fine mineral-led finish. Go directly and with confidence toward the cured and smoked salmon.	\$15	\$65
<b>RUA Pinot Rosé 2020</b> Wildly exotic fruit salad perfume of jasmine, lily, strawberries & watermelon. The centre palate is creamy and concentrated with fine skin tannins coupled with balancing, bright and juicy acidity. Delicious!	\$14.5	\$60
<b>Alchemy Ice 2019 (375ml)</b> Made from blast frozen Riesling and Gewürztraminer grapes, this is an exotic sweet wine. Layers of flavours with apricot, lychee and honeyed caramel. A perfect balance between acidity and richness.	\$13.5	\$75
